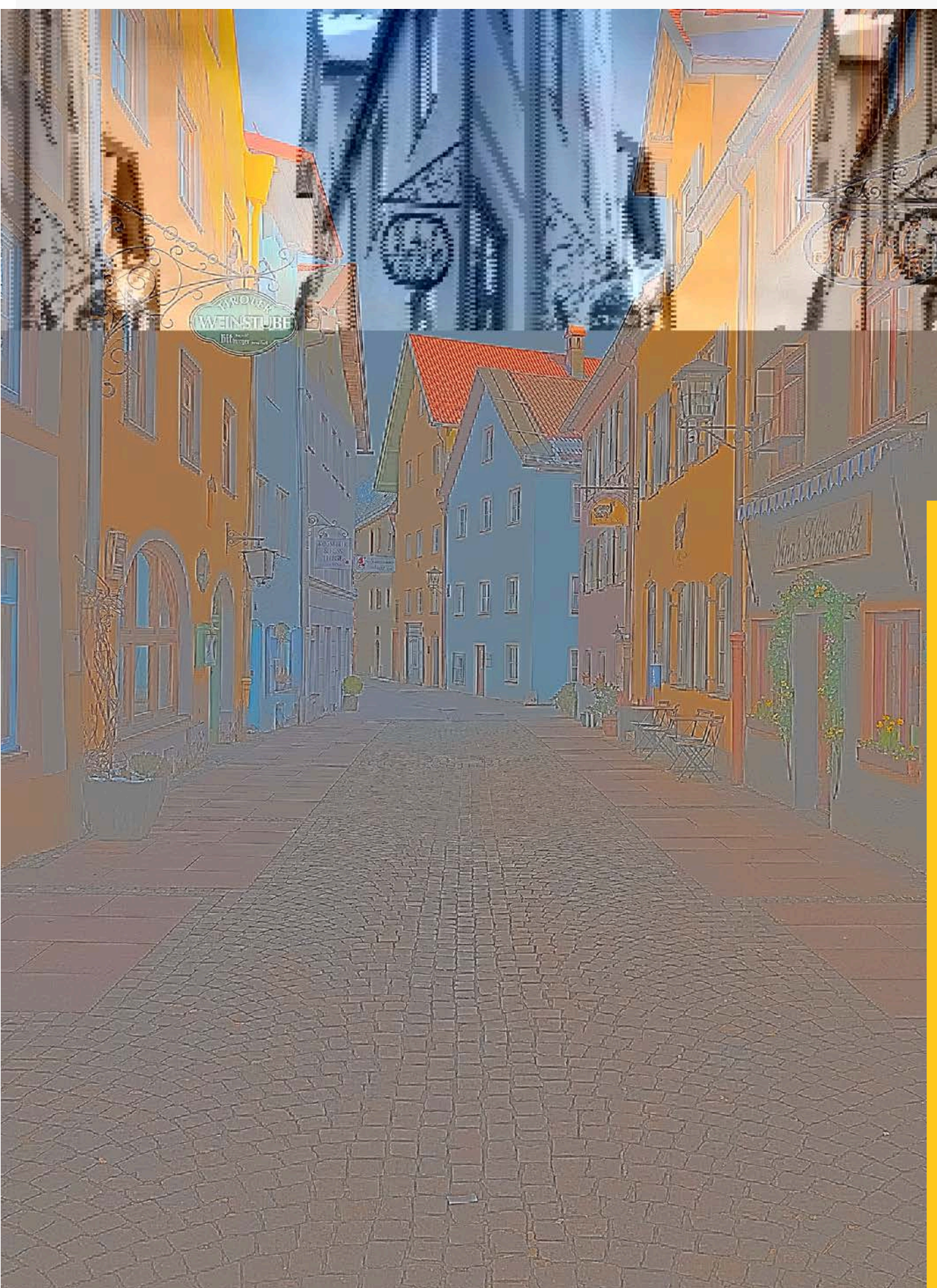

Supplementing Grants

Capacity building support in the fields of Internationalisation, Cultural Enterprise and Management, and Cultural Indicators & Statistics.

Grants to support local and regional festivals, cultural and cross-innovation projects.

Mobility scheme for individual artists and culture professionals to EU and across EaP region.

Who can Apply ?

Geographical eligibility criteria

- » Non-capital city/ town in **Armenia, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Republic of Moldova, Ukraine** and
- » Fully controlled by official governments as recognised by international law and
- » With unfettered accessibility and with sustainable, verified safety and security for all target groups.

Specific eligibility criteria

- ✓ **ARMENIA** - **15 000+** inhabitants
- ✓ **AZERBAIJAN** - **50 000+** inhabitants
- ✓ **GEORGIA** - **15 000+** inhabitants
- ✓ **REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA** - **15 000+** inhabitants
- ✓ **UKRAINE** - **200 000+** inhabitants
