

Szombathely – Social and Economic Context

- Located in Central Europe
- Middle-sized city in West Hungary
- 136 km from Vienna
- app. 80 000 inhabitants
- Industry: labor-intensive, with automotive dominance
- Political opposition city management
- Less secured municipality funding ¼ of our city incomes is lost because of the Covid
- Challenge: shift from labour- to knowledge-intensive ecosystem & find alternative financing options, EU funds
- > **Solutions**: taking part in various EU initiatives & creating:
 - a short-term &
 - > a 10-year economic development programme





Short-term programme: Szombathely ReStart

Holistic approach - respecting social inclusions while maintaining sustainable competitiveness for the broad ecosystem, in order to reinforce adaptation to the post-covid era.

Key intervention areas:

- 1. Social assistance benefits financial subsidy for the dismissed labor force due to Covid
- 2. Three pillars of ReStart Program:
 - Buy Local market voucher program, support and promotion of local supplier relationships
 - 2. Be Online support for SMEs to go online webpage, webshop, social media representation, online invoicing software
 - 3. Spend Wisely rent allowance & public space usage fee discount for SMEs





Short-term programme: Szombathely ReStart

Evidence of Success:

- 50% of the allocated budget spent for social, 40% for entrepreneurial activities
- 3.213 people requested financial subsidy for dismissed labor force due to Covid-19 (300€/person)
- 1.047 people got the market voucher (in value of 100 EUR/person)
- **54 SMEs** got rent allowance
- 23 SMEs got public space usage fee discount in 2020, in 2021 it's free for everyone




